WeArtCo. is a non-profit organization that assists the next generation of youth fashion and beauty leaders. WeArtCo. was founded in 2019 to guide and encourage youth to avoid common mistakes and educate them on the reality of each industry before they enter the career path of their choice. Our mission is to provide one \$1,000 scholarship each year in August to help financially assist a student through school and/or finance their business.

The story behind the birth of WeArtCo. includes a common mistake young people sometimes make by being too eager and ambitious about their careers. At 18, I studied cosmetology at Empire, Morrow Beauty School and I wanted to gain more real-life experience in the beauty industry. Young and excited about improving my skills, I found a beauty salon a few minutes away from my school and signed a contract without giving it much thought. I was told the owners would teach me the skills to improve my services. In a few weeks, the salon environment became very hostile. I felt like giving up on my dreams. The owners weren't teaching me anything. After 2 months, I gained the courage to walk away from the salon until I completed my credits and graduated from school. The owners were furious with me leaving so soon and ended up locking the doors and forcing me to pay a lump sum of money to receive my supplies back from inside the salon. I was devastated. A few years passed and I rebranded into the fashion production industry. I took the lesson that I learned years ago and used it as a way to start WeArtCo.
